Choose whom you will serve

God or Self

Scary Tension

This text sits in a larger context

The same context as "My yoke is easy; my burden is light"

The Kingdom of Heaven Will Be Like This...

Metaphor and NOT a Law If you do these things this will happen This will happen if you don't

Which are you?

Are you going to be responsible? Are you going to be prepared?

Moses gave us 10 commandments as principles Jesus led us into a way of life

Do you follow (obey)
or
Do you not (foolishness)

Jesus is not using scripture as principles Rather, as a way of life!

Are you obeying?
Are you saying I wish I had followed their way?

... I wish I had prepared my lamp?

What are the consequences of not being ready?

What happens if half of the bridal party is not ready because of your foolishness?

Who's going to suffer because of your foolishness?

Who will not come to know Jesus because of what they see in your behavior and what they hear in your words?

People depend on them to have their lamp lit

Someone else pays the cost for their foolishness

Neglect the obligation, gifts or ministry given to them

Who suffers in the church when we waste our resources on things other than for mercy?

You are the Light of the World

What happens when that light doesn't shine?

What are the consequences when we do not have enough oil for those lamps to be lit?

The Kingdom of Heaven will be like this...

The passion narrative and the death of Jesus

Pushing the kingdom forward

Keeping our lamps burning, in spite of, the horrible things ahead

The next part of the gospel goes into a very dark place
