Martha slays them all and wins the town over to Christianity.

Luke 10:38-42

Martha shows hospitality

Mary sits at the feet of Jesus

PROBLEM!

Jesus tells Martha ...
that Mary chose the better part

Good Samaritan

Now he says sitting is better than serving?

Remember who the author is...Luke

Prayer and Study
or
Hospitality and Service

Martha

Welcomes Jesus showing hospitality

"Those who welcome you will be blessed, and that the kingdom of God has come near to them."

Welcoming is the act of a true disciple in Luke.

Martha is doing the right thing.

Mary

Mary sits and listens.

Both are acts of a disciple as described in the New Testament.

The Better Part

Who and Which One?

Trouble when Jesus says Martha is distracted by many things

Martha's serving isn't a bad thing – it's that she was distracted by the wrong things.

She was focused on her sister not helping (similar - prodigal son)

Luke not prioritizing one act of discipleship over another.

We can do 'right' and good things but still be distracted by the 'wrong' things.

We can focus more on the perceived shortcomings of those around us, than on our own relationship with Jesus.

Jesus is always the "better part"
